"HE DIED"

John 19:16-30 / January 17, 2016

- **IT IS FINISHED...HE DIED (what eye-witnesses thought)**
 - Pilate – another Jewish crisis is finished (vs. 16, 19, & 22)
 - Jewish leaders – this “Jesus thing” is finished (v. 21)
 - The soldiers – a day’s work is finished (vs. 18a, 23-24)
 - Mary Magdalene with the women – my savior is finished (v. 25, see Luke 8:2)
 - Mary, Jesus’ mother – my son’s life is finished (vs. 25-27)
 - John, disciple whom he loved – our dreams are finished (vs. 25-27, see 25)
- **IT IS FINISHED...HE DIED (what Jesus knew – Hebrews 12:2)**
 - THE sacrifice is finished (Exodus 12:22, Matthew 27:45&46a, Psalm 51:7, John 1:29, I Corinthians 5:7, Revelation 5)
 - Death is finished (Luke 23:46, John 10:18)
 - Sin is finished (Romans 5:6-11; Hebrews 10:3&4, 11-14)

Because he’s finished, I’m not finished (Philippians 1:6)

Prayers for ECC

- Thank God today for giving his life for your sin on the cross. Use this time to confess specific sins you have or are struggling with and thank him for the sacrifice of Jesus on your behalf.
- God is not finished with you, so ask him to help you grow in the areas he is growing in you.
