- Beginning: pilgrimage continued
 - A place to "settle" (v. 4-6,11)
 - Days and years (v. 8-9)
- Blessing: Covenant Continued
 - Jacob's life of "blessing" (Genesis 27:27-37, 31:22-32, 30:27, 49:28)
 - Jacob blesses Pharaoh (v. 7&10)
 - Blessing fulfilled (Genesis 12:1-3, 28:14, 47:25)
- The blessing at the journey's end is just the beginning
