### START - The finish line in Athens (Panathenaic Stadium, circa 329 BC)

How to run the race for being "made":

- 1. Forget what lies behind (v. 13)
- 2. Strain forward (vs. 12, 13 and 14)
  - a. "taking hold"
  - b. pressing and straining
  - c. training with Paul (I Corinthians 9:25&27)
- 3. [Run] for the prize (v. 14)
  - a. Resurrection is the context (vs. 10&11)
  - b. Race prizes and crowns (I Corinthians 9:25, I Peter 5:4)
  - c. Upward call of God
- 4. Keep running
  - a. We have "not obtained"... (12)
  - b. ...but "we have attained" (16)
  - c. There is a finish (II Timothy 4:7&8)

FINISH - One thing (Hebrews 12:1)
