Intro – a tangled mess of Christmas lights

- **A PEOPLE WALKING IN DARKNESS...DEEP DARKNESS (Isaiah 9:2)**
 - The word gives light for the way (119:105)
 - Darkness walking (Isaiah 9:2, Psalm 119:121-144)
- **HAVE SEEN A GREAT LIGHT...ON THEM HAS LIGHT SHONE (Isaiah 9:2)**
 - The word gives light for understanding (119:130 – see also vs. 125 & 144)
 - Prophecy. Fulfilled. (Matthew 4:12-16)

Wait. Why did you put these Scriptures together? Luke 24:44

- **FOR TO US A CHILD IS BORN**
 - The word becomes flesh and gives light to the world (Psalm 119:135, John 1:5)
 - Prophecy. Fulfilled. (Isaiah 9:6, Luke 2:6&7)
 - Light. (Genesis 1:3, John 1:9)
