Author's Notes:

Because we are loved, we love. This order is important. Although God has many more attributes, love completes the picture of a life in fellowship with God. David Guzik's commentary of this passage is right, "You can't truly grow in your experience of God without also growing in your love for one another." At Eastview we would agree whole-heartedly. Ridiculously loving those around us (those who know Jesus and those who do not) propels our growth as Christfollowers. Unbelievers can love others to some degree, but not in the same way that Christ-followers can love. The new commandment that Jesus gives us in John 13:34-35 should be a bedrock characteristic of Christ-followers at Eastview.
