Family Context: Three generations

 - By keeping a close watch our ourselves
 - By making progress
- IN OUR OLD AGE WE SPEAK BEST...
 - With a mouth filled with praise (Psalm 71:8)
 - With a mouth that tells of salvation (Psalm 71:15)
 - To another generation (Psalm 71:17&18)
