Ezekiel 2:1-7 / October 4, 2015

Ezekiel – taken captive 597 BC, prophesied circa. 590-571 BC

Chapters 1-3 Ezekiel called by God to speak

Chapters 4-24 Ezekiel speaks prophecies of coming judgment/destruction of Jerusalem

Chapters 25-32 Ezekiel speaks against nations that mocked God and his people

Chapters 33-48 Ezekiel speaks of visions of redemption through Jesus (Messiah)

- **WHETHER THEY HEAR OR REFUSE TO HEAR (vs. 5&7)**
 - “rebels who have rebelled” (vs. 3,5,6,7)
 - “have transgressed against me” (v. 3)
 - “impudent and stubborn” (v. 4, see also 3:7)
- **WE SPEAK...**
 - ...because God has spoken to us (vs. 1-3, see also 1:3 and Hebrews 1:1&2)
 - ...because God Spirit is in us (v. 2, see also Acts 1:8a)
 - ...because God has sent us (vs. 3&4, see also Matthew 28:19ff and Acts 1:8b)
 - ...so they will know (v. 5)
