- WHEN LIFE IS DARK (a very messy life vs. 6, 12, 18 see also I Chronicles 25:1-7)
 - o I am dying (vs. 3,4,5,6,10,11,12,15)
 - I am a man with no strength (I am helpless vs. 4, 15)
 - o I am shut in (vs. 8)
 - I am alone ("shunned" vs. 8, 18)
 - O How should I respond?
- PERSISTENTLY CRY TO GOD (indicates relationship)
 - O Lord, God of my salvation (vs. 1)
 - Cry (three words vs. 1,9,13)
 - Day and night (vs. 1, 9, 13)
- QUESTION GOD (indicates faith)
 - Six Questions ("do you...?" vs. 10-12)
 - Two Questions ("why...?" vs. 14&15)
